



*Dear Parents & Coaches,*

*We have survived the first week of games. Since this was our first week at the CB Complex we now know there are a few kinks that need to be worked out. Please note the following for future games at this site:*

*There is **NO** parking on Richard Downing Avenue, soccer fields or any areas that are not paved. This includes the grassy areas around the soccer fields. Beginning this Sunday, we will have two security people directing traffic and parking. Police will be issuing tickets and/or towing any vehicles parked along Richard Downing Avenue. This issue could result in our contract with the city being terminated and we would no longer be allowed to utilize these fields, so please work with us.*

*Please try to carpool families when possible or ask family members to come at game time rather than earlier, to allow the previous games attendees to leave and free up space in the parking lots. All trailers, etc. are not allowed, as posted, at the Complex. These only take up space that another parent or elderly person could use. Handicap parking is for marked vehicles only. There are three lots that we will use for parking. Parking is also available in the southwest corner of the JC Penney lot. Be prepared to park a distance from the field and walk. The concession trailer will be placed in the middle of the fields beginning this Sunday which will free up more spaces in the first lot.*

*This is City Property and smoking is **not** allowed. Pets are also not allowed.*

*Anyone wanting to keep track of their child's playing time will find sheets at the table under the tent. All coaches playing time sheets should be turned in to the same table.*

*Please have patience with all staff, directors and coaches. Everyone you see involved with this program, other than officials are volunteers and are not paid for their services. They are giving up their free time to make this program the best it can be for your children and hope that it will be a positive, fun learning experience for them. As time goes on, you will continue to see improvements at these fields that will only make them a better place for our kids to play.*
